Special Meeting

Maurice Wagoner, President of the Over-the-Rhine Community Council, has called for a special meeting of the membership of the Over-the-Rhine Community Council on **Tuesday February 12th at 6 PM at the Over-the-Rhine Rec Center (the Hub)**.

The reason for this meeting is the need to vote on a Quality of Life Agreement with FC Cincinnati, as requested by members of City Council, in advance of a City Council vote on February 13, regarding the team's plan for the stadium.
